### **SB police offer child car seat inspections**

San Bernardino – The San Bernardino Police Department, San Bernardino County, Children's Network and Safe Kids conducted a Child Safety Seat Clinic from 8 to 11:30 a.m. on Oct. 16.

Ten certified safety seat technicians, six of whom were San Bernardino traffic police officers, worked at the event. The event took place at a Walmart parking lot at 4001 Hallmark Parkway. The workers inspected and installed child restraint seats in 26 cars and identified 11 seats as being unsafe. The 11 unsafe seats were traded in for new ones and parents were educated on how to properly install the seats in addition to other safety issues. The San Bernardino Police Department is still conducting child restraint seat inspections and individuals can call the San Bernardino Police Traffic Unit to schedule an appointment.
