Clifford the Big Red Dog helped the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Redlands-Riverside celebrate the newest additions to their bookshelves, all thanks to the generosity of The UPS Store.

Employees of local UPS Store franchises delivered 283 cartons of books, worth about \$25,000, on Tuesday afternoon, April 9, to the Boys & Girls Clubs headquarters in Redlands. The donation was made possible by the company's participation in the Toys for Tots Literacy Program, a year-round initiative of the Marine Toys for Tots Foundation.

Locally, The UPS Store has donated \$58,000 in books in the past three years, according to a news release from the Boys & Girls Clubs.

The donations benefit the 14,000 children served by Boys & Girls Clubs locations in Redlands, Riverside, Fontana, Barstow, Coachella Valley, Palm Springs, Cathedral City, Menifee, Temecula, Yucca Valley and Beaumont/Banning.
