“Spirit room” tastings, food, and \$100 in “fun money” for casino games are included in the ticket price.

Additionally, each guest will receive a special commemorative stemless wine glass, and can enter a raffle for a Dell Inspiron 15.6-inch laptop with 8GB memory.

Participating restaurants include Old Spaghetti Factory, Buffalo Wild Wings, the Mitten Building, Napoli Italian Restaurant, Molly’s Café and Nothing Bundt Cakes.
