Boys & Girls Club hosting COVID vaccine clinics

REDLANDS – Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Redlands-Riverside, Anthem Blue Cross and Ralphs Pharmacy are partnering to hold vaccination clinics for all local residents over age 12.

The clinics are at the Club, 1251 Clay St., Redlands, and are scheduled:

- July 22, 4-7 p.m. (first dose of Pfizer-BioNTech)
- Aug. 12, 4-7 p.m. (second dose)
- Sept. 18, 11 a.m.-2 p.m. (first dose of Pfizer-BioNTech)
- Oct. 9, 11 a.m.-2 p.m. (second dose)

The Sept. 18 clinic will be offered during the Club's Day for Kids block party. Day for Kids celebrates youth and the community they live in, and offers families a chance to spend time together. There will be food, games, fun activities, music, crafts, and informational booths.

Adults who get the first dose at either clinic will receive a \$50 Ralphs/Food 4 Less gift card and recipients ages 12-18 will receive a \$50 Target gift card after the second dose.

Ralphs will provide giveaways during Day for Kids and Anthem will provide water.

The Club has been open for youth since May 2020 under COVID-19 safety measures, and is currently holding summer day camp.
